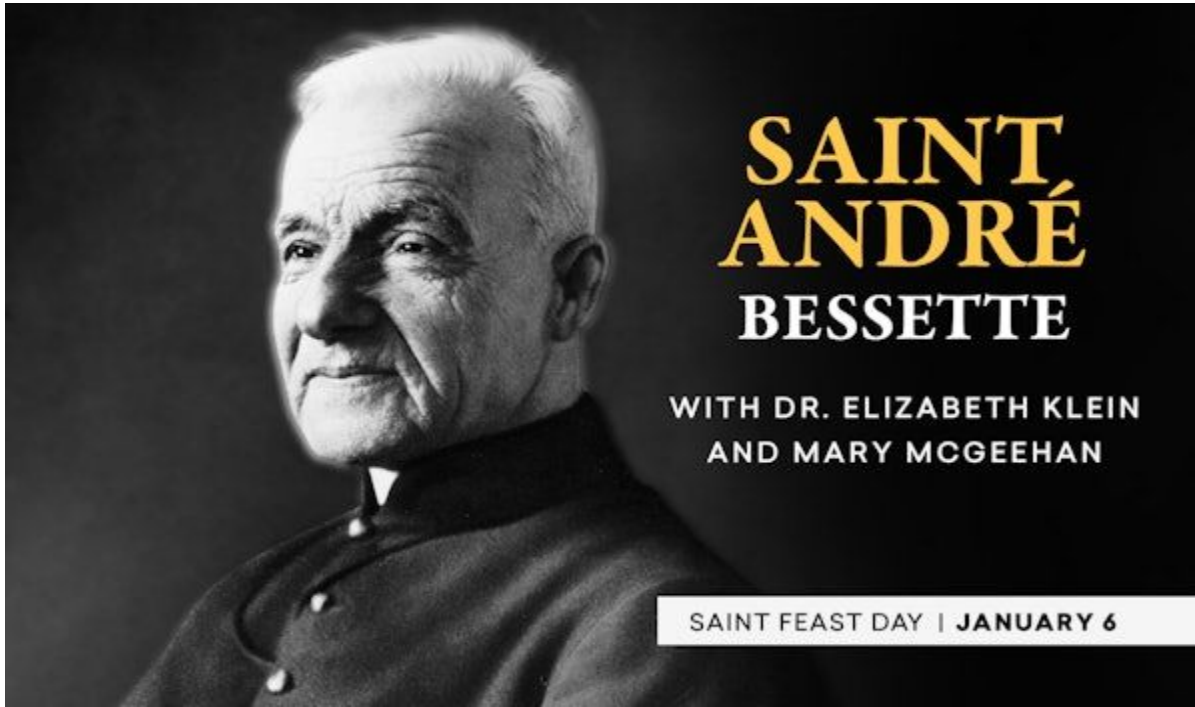
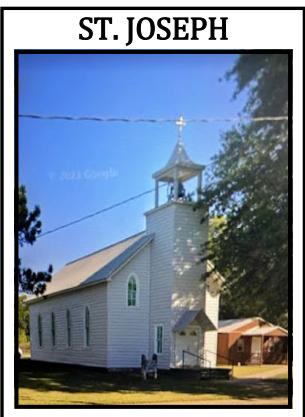
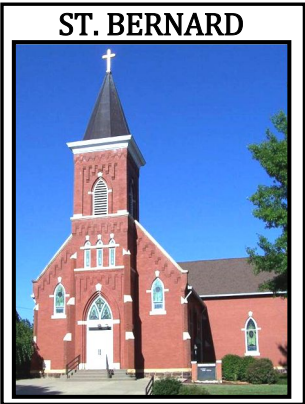

A MILLION MEMORARES *for hope*

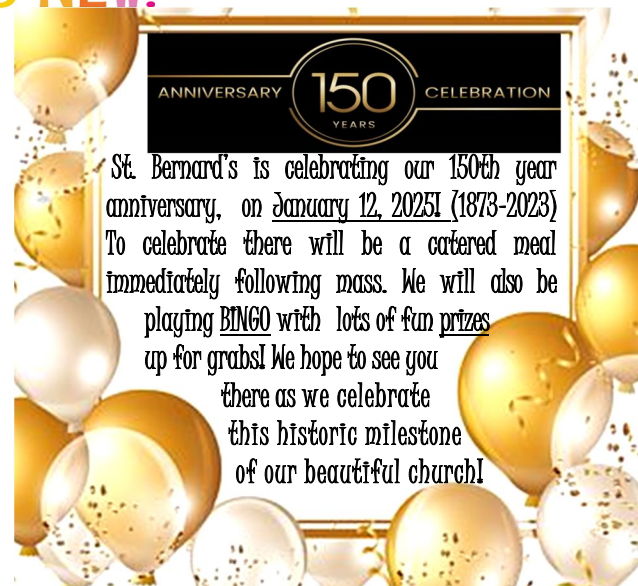

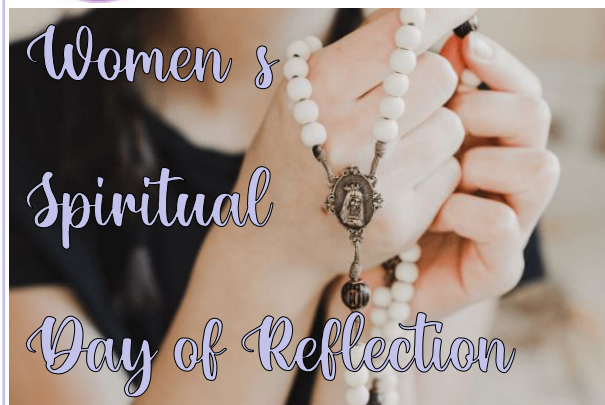
